

# PRESIDENT-ELECT

The President-Elect serves as the IDEC BOD representative overseeing Governance and Communications. In the absence or disability of the President, the President-Elect performs the duties and responsibilities of the President.

#### **Election & Term of Service**

Election: Elected by the membership

**Term**: 1 year (1 year as President-Elect, followed by 1 year as President, followed by 1 year as Immediate Past-President)

Responsibilities begin May 1 and conclude April 30. New officers attend the Board meeting held in conjunction with the annual conference prior to beginning their term of office for transition and orientation.

Time Commitment: 5 hours per week

## **Responsibilities and Duties**

- Serves on the Board of Directors and carries out Board responsibilities as outlined in the Elected Leaders Responsibilities section of this document.
- Performs duties and exercises power of the office of the President in the absence or disability of the President.
- With the assistance of IDEC staff, maintains the bylaws and submits proposed bylaws revisions to the Board and subsequently to the membership.
- Prepares goals and objectives for their term as President of IDEC.
- Serves as a representative to professional organizations and events (as directed by the President).
- Serves as Chair of the Communications Committee.
- Serves as a member of the Executive Committee.
- Serves as a member of the Finance Committee.
